

Postsecondary education is highly desirable, as many Jordanians are eager to pursue a successful professional career. To apply for a place at one of the public universities, candidates need to attain a result of 65 percent or more in the Tawjihi Exams and hold the Tawjihi Certificate.

The higher education system in Jordan every year provides Jordanians with the necessary skills and training to enable them to enter the job market. Obtaining interpersonal and leadership skills, as well as the ability to work as part of a team, are essential requirements for success in today's highly demanding work environment.


