The Dragon Boat Festival has been celebrated by the Chinese on the fifth day of the lunar month . This year that day is 6th June . syptians developed writing about 6,000 years ago . Scribes were among the few people who could read write . They decorated their temples with <u>hieroglyphics</u>, which Egyptians called "the world of god". The yptians developed hieroglyphic writing at the same time as Sumerian writing was developed on soft clay . Jowever, the Egyptians didn't write on clay; they wrote on papyrus, wood and rock walls.

People wrote hieroglyphics in rows and columns . In the case of rows you can read <u>them</u> from left to right or from right to left . In the case of a column , you must read from the top to bottom .
