A - MOVING MOUNTAINS

- Vern Jones fulfilled his lifelong dream of climbing Mount Kilimanjaro at age 62 in 2014.
- He recognized the important role of guides, who work in difficult conditions with minimal pay and poor equipment.
- In response, he founded Kili Summit Club to support the guides by raising funds through mountain gear sales.
- The guides receive proper footwear, equipment and commission from sales, ensuring ongoing support from climbers.

B - KINDNESS IS AS EASY AS PIE

- In 2012, Lisa Ludwinski started her pie business from her parents' kitchen, initially selling 40 pies.
- Encouraged by positive feedback, she continued her business education and gained experience.
- She raised funds for her bakery, including a 24-hour fundraising effort that collected \$26,593.
- In April 2015, she opened Sister Pie in Detroit, Michigan.
- Lisa emphasizes community involvement in her business philosophy.
- She introduced the 'Pie it Forward' system, allowing customers to buy coupons that strangers in need can use for free pie slices.

- في أبريل 2015، افتتحت Sister Pie في ديترويت، ميشيغان.
- تؤكد ليزا على المشاركة المجتمعية في فلسفة عملها.
- قدمت نظام "Pie it Forward"، الذي يسمح للعملاء بشراء قسائم يمكن للغرباء المحتاجين استخدامها للحصول على شرائح فطيرة مجانية.

C - THE MILK OF HUMAN KINDNESS

- In 2015, Tracy Warshal helped a stranger at a shop by paying for his groceries when he forgot his wallet.
- The stranger thanked her, asked her name, and left.
- A month later, Tracy's colleagues at a cancer charity informed her that the man had donated \$10,000 to the foundation in her name.
- He identified her because she was wearing a charity T-shirt at the time.
- Tracy expressed joy that her small act of kindness led to a significant impact and hoped it would inspire others to do the same.
