Technological changes have affected many areas of life in Europe. These are three changes that have affected European travelling habits in recent years.

Eurotunnel : In 1994 a tunnel linking Britain with the mainland of Europe was opened to the public. This project, which had been planned for many years, was paid for jointly by the French and British governments.

Electronic road tolls : Motorists have to pay to drive on motorways in Italy. Under the original system, all cars had to stop at kiosks at the beginning or the end of a section of motorway and pay cash. Now, there is a high-tech alternative called Telepass. Under this new system, cars are " recognised " so they do not have to stop. The money is taken automatically from each driver's bank account.

Online booking : The cheapest and quickest way of buying train or airline tickets is now to book "online". This involves logging on to the Internet, finding the correct website, typing in your travel requirements and personal details and paying by credit card. Passengers can then print a receipt which may also be the "ticket" which they show at the airport or railway station. This is all done without the need for any personal contact with the airline or rail company.
